Policy on Grant making:

The Trustees of LA VIDA Endeavour to directly grant funding to specific projects that relieve sickness and/or improve education in any Latin American country. Preference will be given to independent projects, but the trustees could also look to partner with local organisations that will see through the success and completion of compelling projects in health and education in Latin America.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year Donations and fundraising have allowed us to improve and directly benefit the lives of 6,240 children across Latin America. In 2008 we continued to support our inaugural project in Brazil to train orthopaedic surgeons across all regions of Brazil to treat clubfoot with the Ponseti Technique which has a 94% success rate. 7,000 Brazilian children are born with clubfoot each year in Brazil and they should now all have access to trained surgeons. The project which was the founding reason for our charity has now been completed and it was a great success. We now have plenty of other projects to focus on. In 2008, we raised £43,350 through our annual sponsored 10K run, a "Brazilian Frenzy" night with Fashion show, a raffle, a live auction and donations. We had some very generous individuals that had their donations matched by their employers as well. During 2008, £24,500 was distributed across different projects across Latin America.

- 1) Completion of the Brazil Ponseti Technique project
- 2) A hospital in Guatemala to prevent malnutrition in new born babies which is an ongoing commitment;
- 3) We provided equipment (PCs, Books, Educational materials) for the Villa Maria School in Lima Peru
- 4) Scholarships to 26 kids from an under-privileged area in Lima Peru to attend a school the Villa Maria School
- 5) Support for the Siao Orphanage in Brasilia is still under study after recent changes in management of the institution.

For 2009, we have instituted a Sponsor a Child program for an additional 20 disadvantaged children in Lima Peru to attend the Villa Maria School. We are supporting further equipment enhancement of the Villa Maria School. We have a new project in Bolivia supporting 9 disadvantaged but hard working students to complete their University Education in La Paz. We also plan to support a campaign for the prevention of Spina Bifida in Guatemala. We have scheduled another 10K sponsored run as well as a Latin American themed party fund-raiser.
